

# Self Guided Tour

The Alliance for Sustainable Colorado bought this historic warehouse 2004 and then renovated five of the floors to create the Alliance Center. During the process of converting open spaces and renovating offices, materials were chosen considering their impacts on the environment. Design ideas encourage collaboration and interaction among tenants and are ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) friendly.

You are welcome to tour the public spaces throughout all five floors and the basement. You will find educational signs highlighting features and materials that are readily available for use in other buildings. Many of these features and materials are identified under six tracks consistent with the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED® (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) rating system.

Other features are identified which highlight **Collaboration**, **Accessibility**, and Historic preservation.
