

Vision for the Future

The Alliance for Sustainable Colorado is facilitating establishment of a statewide sustainability movement. The Alliance opened the Alliance Center to create a hub for a national network of statewide sustainability movements and a place where ideas, strategies and best practices can be learned, exchanged and developed.

In its first phase, The Alliance Center has become home to over 30 nonprofits and a nucleus for interaction and collaboration. Working at the same location creates synergies that enhance developing common visions, programs, strategies and campaigns. Co-locating also enables capacity building and fundraising, while reducing expenses through economies of scale and shared costs. The Center is a gathering place for advocates of sustainability in Denver and from across the state and even outside the state.

A goal of the Alliance is to double the office and meeting space available at the Alliance Center. Construction of a new building on the adjoining parking lot will provide a total of



over 60,000 sq. ft. of space for offices, meetings and trainings for non-profit tenants and non-tenant partners. The Center will include versatile event and conference facilities, public corridors featuring educational displays of sustainability projects, and amenities such as recycling center, kitchen, exercise room, showers and underground parking. The Alliance for Sustainable Colorado will undertake a capital campaign to raise \$15 million for this project.
